# Iowa School for the Deaf Summer Camp!

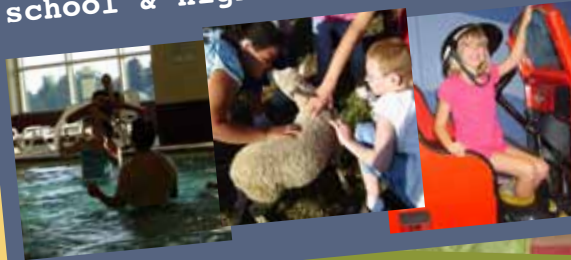


For children who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, hearing impaired, use spoken or sign language, cochlear implants, hearing aids or no assistive devices.
