POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT: FOODWORKER

Duties:

- Measure and combine ingredients, assists in preparing foods, and perform cooking tasks for menu items as specified
- Transport and set up food and equipment for service areas; replenish as needed
- Serve food in serving line
- Performs sanitation duties in serving, dining, and kitchen area
- Serve as checker and report number of persons served to enable accurate record keeping
- Performs other duties as assigned

The tasks listed are examples of the variety and general nature of duties performed by employees. It is not intended that any position include every duty listed nor is it intended that related duties cannot be required

Qualifications:

- Ability to read, write, and follow instructions
- Knowledge of methods and practices of food preparation, sanitation, and service
- Ability to perform physical tasks such as lifting (50 pounds), bending, and standing for prolonged periods
- Maintain effective working relationships with others
- Ability to maintain records of quantities of ingredients used, volume of production, and numbers of customers served
- Previous experience working with students who are deaf/hard of hearing or blind/visually impaired is preferred

All staff are expected to reach the designated level of sign language proficiency within the time frame of the school's sign language policy.

Hours: School year, Monday-Thursday 9:30am-7:00pm, Friday 9:30am-1:30pm (hours may shift occasionally as needed); with occasional weekend hours

Pay/Benefits: entry pay \$13.89/hr; health and dental insurance, retirement plan options, flex spending accounts, and more
